A positive development to emerge in careers education from lockdown is the number of support videos being made by employers, universities and colleges to support students' Futures Education.

Students who have four encounters with employers during their education were twice as likely to understand the knowledge and skills needed to be successful in the workplace.

Whilst it proves challenging to invite visitors in to school Magna Futures Online can ensure our students still get this vital careers support. All students and parents will be sent information about the up and coming online



opportunities.

With the information about the Futures Online support will be a link to a Google Form. We are asking students to complete a short questionnaire about what they have taken part in. This will allow us to build up a careers profile for our students and provide early intervention for those who are not engaging.
