Dear Parent/Carer,

Re: Key Stage 4 Blood Brothers Theatre Trip, Thursday 9th September 2021

We are delighted to offer our Key Stage 4 drama, music and dance students the opportunity to watch 'Blood Brothers' at The Mayflower Theatre, Southampton, on Thursday 9th September. 'Blood Brothers' is a play that many students study as part of their set texts in either English or Performing Arts studies. This will be a focal point for Year 10 drama and music students this year as it is part of their performing arts qualification.

The performance begins at 7:30pm and will last approximately 2 hours and 45 minutes, with a short interval. The trip is being offered at the cost of £24.85 per student, to include the price of the theatre ticket and return coach travel. We are scheduled to leave Magna Academy at 2:30pm and due to return around 11:30pm. Students will be advised to contact home when the coach is close to the academy, ready for you to pick up your child. If you arrange other means of transport for your child to be collected, please advise us of their transport home. Students will not be allowed to walk home, as we will be arriving back late at night.

Students will be able to get changed at the academy during lunch time and will need to make sure they are appropriately dressed for the theatre. Appropriate dress would include smart casual clothing. After they are changed, students will report to the main hall to register with their group leader. If student's have not eaten their lunch, they are able to do so as they sit in the main hall whilst waiting for the groups to be arranged for the coach.

Once in Southampton, students will be escorted to West Quay food hall where they will be able to purchase food prior to the performance, so it would be advisable for them to bring some money if they wish to do so. If they would prefer, students can bring a packed meal to eat instead. The group will leave West Quay at 6:15pm to walk to the theatre ready for the performance start time.

As we are now a cashless academy we are asking parents to pay for this trip via ParentPay. If you would like your child to attend this trip, please complete the consent slip on ParentPay, when making payment, by Thursday 15th July.
