Academy Closure 18 February 2022 - Remote Learning Provision

Following on from my email earlier today, I am writing to confirm that Remote Learning will be provided via Google Classroom for the academy closure tomorrow. Students should follow their usual timetable and endeavour to complete all work set to the best of their ability. This will start with meeting their tutor at 8:30am, to ensure that all students are clear about the structure of the day. Students will be able to access either a live instruction or instructional video for each timetabled lesson. Students will access these through either their Google calendar or the 'stream' within their class-specific Google Classroom. The instructional input will last around 10 minutes and be accompanied by activities to be completed within that hour. Please be aware that some staff live in remote locations and may lose connectivity if there are power outages in their area. As a minimum, staff will do their best prior to the start of the lesson, so that there is work to complete.


In addition, students will also have access to Hegarty Maths and Tassomai which provides activities in English, Maths and Science. We also encourage students to continue self-quizzing using their Knowledge Organisers, following their daily homework timetable. As students will not have access to their DEAR books, all students will meet virtually with their tutor at this time as normal, who will check how their day has gone.

Students and teachers may use academy emails, the 'stream' on Google Classroom or the private comments function to communicate with each other about the work (also available for Hegarty Maths and Tassomai).

If families are still having trouble accessing Google Classroom, they should contact the relevant Head of Year via the academy [website](#). However, should there be power outages which disrupt remote learning, students are encouraged to undertake a combination of Self-quizzing, Reading for Pleasure and effective revision of prior learning.

I would like to take the opportunity to wish everyone a safe and restful half term break.
