

Being part of the forum will normally involve attending meetings in the Academy and following the agreed agenda once every half term. A newsletter about topics discussed during the meeting will be produced and available to all parents of children at the Academy and to all staff.

Additionally, Magna Academy has a supportive, creative and motivated PTFA which we are hoping to grow this year. The PTFA comprises parents, teachers and any associates of Magna Academy who wish to form an organisation working on behalf of and for the good of the academy. Chair

- Lead the meetings
- Uphold the constitution of Magna Academy's PTFA.

Vice Chair

- Support the work of the Chair and lead meetings if the Chair is absent

Secretary

- Take minutes of the meetings
- Deal with any administrative work or correspondence required of the PTFA

Treasurer

- Manage and keep records of the accounts
- Produce a financial report once a year
- Share the accounts with an independent and external auditor
- We strongly recommend that for this role, the post holder has experience in accountancy and bookkeeping
