Re: Red Nose Day 2024 – Friday 15th March

On Friday 15th March, Magna Academy will, once again, be celebrating Red Nose Day in an attempt to raise money for Comic Relief.

As part of our yearly tradition eagerly anticipated by our students, we will once again celebrate Red Nose Day with a 'Wear Something Red!' day on Friday 15th March. Therefore, students will be able to wear one item of clothing that is red in colour along with their full school uniform. Students who choose to wear a red t-shirt or jumper must wear it over their shirt and tie, with their blazer on top (no pictures or slogans which may cause offence). Additionally, we request that students do **not** dye or spray their hair red for the occasion. When wearing one red accessory (e.g. socks, earrings, headband), students must wear it with their full academy uniform, including their school shoes. If students choose to paint their nails red, this must be removed before coming into school on Monday 18th March.

Please note, all uniform will be checked by tutors and heads of houses during morning line ups. Any students who are not appropriately dressed will be sent home to change if their uniform cannot be rectified in school.

The following classes will have practical PE on Friday 15th March, so they should make sure that they bring their full PE kit into school with them, but can choose to wear a red item of clothing or accessory to accompany their PE kit.

P3 – 8S/PE1, 8S/PE2, 8S/PE3
